Summer Meetings & Changes to Prize Drawings

President Caires extends a hearty "Well-Done" to all of the FCC club volunteers who helped during show setup/teardown and those who manned the front desk. Board meeting was held on Aug 6th with some important updates:

Revised Prize Drawing Structure for regular meetings: Due to lower meeting ticket sales, the board is revising the regular meeting prize drawing structure. We are eliminating the gold prize. 




