Aug 10th, 2010 Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm by President Chuck Call. Taylor Web won the door prize. **New Business:** Announcements included upcoming shows and club events. Chuck announced that the Coin Show front-desk, set-up, and tear-down sign up sheets are at the membership desk. Those who volunteer to work at the show will earn a club-paid dinner at the Market Broiler on Sunday evening. Vince Lacariere reported that the bourse is pretty much sold out. Only two "long-term" dealers will not be returning; two FCC members will share one of the vacant tables. Those members who sell one book of tickets receive a special copper club medal; those who sell (2) books of tickets will get (2) medals and a free dinner at the January Installation.
